

Further, the medical hold detention was affected by the VA Police under VA Policy Memorandum No. MH&BSS/116A-07 which states on page 1, 2. POLICY: "in accordance with Arizona Revised Statutes Title 36, subsection 520, 531 and 548. As VA Police under propriatory jurisdiction, we can not enforce state codes. Also, the subject in this case never made any threats, threating or others.
